Canada ended 2018 as the world's first industrialized country to legalize the use of recreational cannabis. This incident caused the cannabis industry to gain traction, especially on the stock market. It has let billions of dollars worth of legitimate annual sales in, making cannabis a booming industry.

According to BDS Analytics and ArcView Market Research, cannabis research and investment groups, the cannabis consumers around the world are expected to spend \$16.9 billion in 2019, which is a 38% jump from an estimate of \$12.2 billion in 2018, and \$9.5 billion in 2017, pushing the global cannabis market to USD \$65 billion by the year 2023.
